

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND SECTION 2-311, "MEMBERS AND TERMS IN OFFICE," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE TO REDUCE THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION ON FIRE AND POLICE PRACTICES TO FOUR YEARS


WHEREAS, the Commission on Fire and Police Practices was established by Ordinance Number 2005-44 in order to hear complaints from the public at large about incidences and individuals serving in those department and to address concerns of departmental employees about established policies and practices; and

WHEREAS, in establishing the Commission, Council approved a term of office of five years for each voting member; and


WHEREAS, Council has found upon review that the term of office is burdensome on the Commission members and not in alignment with the terms of other city boards and commissions and recommends the term of office be reduced to four years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, that Section 2-311, "Members and terms of office," of the Code of Ordinances of the city of Greenville be amended to reduce the term of office for members of the Commission on Fire and Police Practices from five years to four years. Four year terms shall take effect upon the expiration of each current Commissioner's term.


